SAINT-VERAN

LA VIEILLE VIGNE DE SAINT CLAUDE

Type of wine : Dry white wine

Grape Variety : Chardonnay

Yield and density : Yields are 56hl hectares, there are 8,000 hectares.

Age of the vine : 75-year-old.

Terroir and locations : Saint-Claude. The first terroir is facing southeast, it has an altitude of 250 meters. The ground is clay-limestone.

Cultivation Mode : Reasoned control, weeding, ground working.

Grape harvest : Manual grape harvest and pressing of whole bunches.

Fermentation : Fermentation in barrels for one to seven years + a part in vats. The assembly is done 1 month before the bottling these wines on 10 months of breeding.

Tasting : Fresh complex notes with also fresh vanilla notes.

Food and wine : It can perfectly be associated with lobster with citrus butter, white boudin (pudding), and also an oysters gratin.
